

The Pyramid of Power:
Abusers will use these three tactics or strategies to gain control.

New Cycle of Violence

Stage 1 pressure builds & warning signs manifest
Stage 2 unpreventable abusive incident
*Stage 3 critical stage where both abuser and
victim deal with abusive incident differently
(not included in the original cycle of violence)
Stage 4 Apologies build emotional attachment
Stage 5 Everyday routine resumes as if abusive
incident never occurred



Statistics on Domestic Violence:

- * Approximately 85% of domestic violence victims are female.
- ** According to a 2000 UNICEF study, 20-50% of the world's female population will become victims of domestic violence.
- ** The United Nations Development Fund for Women estimates that at least 33% of women globally will be beaten, raped, or otherwise abused during her lifetime. In most cases, the abuser is a member of her own family.
- ** Nearly 1 in 4 (25%) women report experiencing violence by a current or former spouse or boyfriend at some point in her life.
- * In the U.S., at least 2 million women are battered by their partners each year.
- * Is s million children in the IIS live in families where IPV occurs

* The United Nations conservatively estimates that 275 million children worldwide are exposed to violence in their homes.
